1. Apologies

Apologies from – Robin Currie and Trish Collins.

Welcome

At 7pm –Stuart Irvine opened the meeting and welcomed the attendees.

Stuart reported that after a talk by Norman Weir there would be short Windfarm Trust AGM before the actual EKCC meeting.

Then followed a talk from Norman Weir and Jonathon Hooper regarding the issue of broadband in the area between Peninver and Saddell. A group of 26 homes in this area have no cable broadband supply and have to rely on insufficient satellite broadband. BT Open Reach have quoted £27,000 to lay fibre optic cable to these houses. The group with the support of SKDT have been in touch with Better Broadband Scotland who have promised each household £350 each towards the cost of the fibre optic cable. Each household will also contribute money towards this cost to the total of £10,000, leaving a deficit of £10,000. This group have come to the East Kintyre Windfarm Trust asking for a grant of £5,000 this year and £5,000 next year. The point was raised that the Scottish Government have promised that all rural areas will be covered by broadband by 2021, and it may compromise this promise if there are already some fibre optic cable already laid.

The Trust listened to the points made by Norman and Jonathan and agreed to speak to SKDT regarding this issue.

3. AGM of the East Kintyre Windfarm Trust

Conveners and Treasurers report

As Stuart Irvine is both Convener and Treasurer he gave both reports simultaneously, he told us that over the last year 25 applications have been approved to a total of £36,729.55.

The balance of all 3 accounts is £137,417.00

SI also said he wanted to stand down from the position of Treasurer.

Secretary's report

Eleanor Sloan said that the applications are increasing and the required amount of paper based evidence is also increasing. She has asked if the new Treasurer could also take on the role of the preparing of all the admin involved with the bids, and she will continue with minutes at the meetings etc. All agreed.

Alasdair Bennett was proposed for the position of Treasurer and this was unanimously agreed. Alasdair agreed to do this and he and Stuart will begin the transition of hand over of the accounts etc. Alasdair proposed that the existing finance subgroup meets 4 times a year (members of this are SI, ES and AB) and that all the bank statements are presented and signed at regular meetings. All agreed.
