Plans for the yard are being delayed with a temporary, interim shore based solution for the yard. Mowi gave us a commitment to actively encourage new staff to live in the village and to consider partnership in housing.

We have plenty available housing at present and hope that the new fish farm will bring some new residents to the village.

No one present could give an answer but our A&B councillors will make enquiries with the licensing board.

Residents are concerned about the access to the golf club with the unprotected hole in the road. A long discussion took place about the future of village social life without the Cruban bar which was, until relatively recently, the hub for locals and holiday makers alike.

It would be great to have that hub in operation again.

- It was brought to our attention that the requested (on many occasions) single track road signs are still not in place.
- The street lights at Tosh's Park mentioned at December meeting have not yet be repaired.

A&B Councillors will look into both issues and report back.
