1. <u>Welcome</u>

3. Minutes of last meeting - 01/03/18

5. <u>Planning</u>

Application 18/00415/PPP for a dwelling house at Lephinmore, Saddell. No objections.

6. <u>Wind Farm Trust update</u>

Eleanor reported that she and Alasdair Bennett had attended a meeting regarding monies to be shared annually by East Kintyre, West Kintyre and Tarbert & Skipness Community Councils from the Cour Wind farm. The total will be £102,000 annually available in 2 six month tranches and there will be a group, consisting of 3 people from each area, chosen to sit on the application panel. There will be more information regarding this fund when it goes to press.

It was also agreed that the May tranche of the East Kintyre Wind farm trust would have to wait until after the inaugural meeting of the Council – dates will be suggested as soon as possible.

7. <u>Water problem at man-hole cover at harbour</u>

No progress – RC reported that Scottish Water thinks that Argyll and Bute are responsible for this problem. RC to follow up.

8. Brackley Cemetery

No update from Stuart Irvine regarding Mike Russell and Paul Martin – ES to chase up.

RS reported that Forestry Commission Scotland and SSE have graded the road from the road end of the B842 to the entrance of the cemetery.

9. <u>Road signage</u>

NO updates re – the Quay brae signs.

ES received an email from Julian Green saying that the other signs will be put in place when the other works in the village are completed – approx. end of May 2018.

Tommy McPherson – asked about replacing/ repairing some signs in Saddell – he will forward some photos to the council and Robin Currie offered to look into it

It was suggested that we asked Colin Burgess if he would have a bin at the caravan park, near the shore for any rubbish collected on the beach – ES will contact Colin

- Robert showed us a letter he had received from Eilidh Neilson saying that she wants the street light at Port Righ to be fixed as we have already heard from other folk at Port Righ who do not want it fixed EKCC agreed that they cannot take any stance on this point and will ask all concerned to contact ArgyII and Bute Council regarding this matter and find out exactly what is the position for all concerned. RC agreed to look into this.
- Tommy McPherson suggested the playpark committee approaches Marine Harvest for some funding – TM to forward info to ES
- Elaine Batchelor said that some of the trees on the tinkers track are leaning over in a dangerous manner – RS offered to speak to Dougie McCormick about this
- RS offered to trim back some of the gorse at the bay for the Carradale canter RS to trim gorse
- Lesley Prag asked about the website and was assured that people are using it it was suggested that we create a facebook page Lesley offered to do this
