Treasurers Report

Matters Arising

Torrisdale Bay planning – put back to 2026

Torrisdale Bay – layby – IB – after consultation with A&B council – it was never an official layby or bus stop. Official bus stop is opposite gates to Torrisdale castle but this is not what happens in practice.

Tormhor pavement – overgrown. AH was contacted by community payback team and suggested Tormhor. AH will ask for it to be done. IB added that access path across the EKCC field needs cleared and will email AH to ask for that to be done too.

FLS sale – parcels of land on the west side of the road by Auchnasaville (past the farm) and by Dippen wood now on public sale.

Correspondence

Crow Wood – FLS plans to remove paths, bridges etc that were part of a community project from 2002. Awaiting paperwork from person who was EKCC chairperson at the time. EKCC may take ownership – discussing it with FLS. Trying to get FLS to wait so paths, bridges etc are not removed while sorting funding.

LDPG update

JM spoke to TC – should be finished end of the month to present January.

CCT update

Russ confirmed ladder signage funded, awaiting new signs. Similar to existing but composite. Getting quotes for culvert at network centre.

Headstones at Cemetery

Aw asked what can be done with fallen down headstones as council leave them. AH will check but thinks it is families responsibility.

School Clusters

Alastair Redman raised that school clusters were coming back around again. AH voiced that she is against them but notes that school nos are dropping.

Carradale Business Group

Niall Macallister Hall raised that the group had notes that services on the east side of the village are under signposted. You could drive through the main road and not realise there was anything on the other side. TommyMacPherson raised postentially signposting the harbour. AH will ask the council.
