SSEN – Donation of Defibrillators for Saddell and Peninver

Ian will enquire about connection to electrical supply and will liaise with Mike Reid about positioning of the Peninver machine.

Ian reported that the Crossaig transmission station is going to increase in size(triple) from Feb/March 24. The new higher power line from Tangy to Carradale will also be installed March 2024.

95% of the old pylons will be taken down and could be utilised for sculpture.
